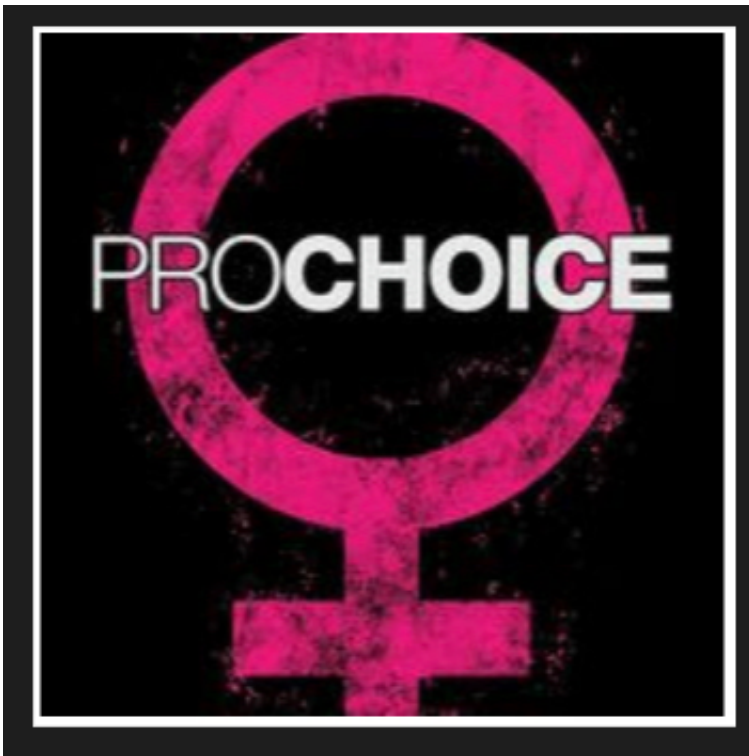

If you are at least 16 years old, you can earn from \$175 to \$320 a day by working during Early Voting or on Election Day.

Mail-In Ballots - Answers

From Katherine Berry, Election Director, Carroll County Board of Elections:

To clarify a few questions that I've received regarding the mail in ballots:

1. Military and overseas ballots were sent out prior to the June 4 deadline.
2. Domestic mail in ballots are expected to be in the mailstream June 9 with arrival in voter mailboxes on June 13.
3. We will have a tracking system for voter's ballots available on our website and social media in the next week or so. The State Board of Elections is putting final touches on this system, so I will alert you when it's available for any of your constituents that may be wondering where their ballot is.
4. Drop boxes will be delivered to 6 locations on June 7. SBE has instructed us to open these boxes on June 13. Election officials will be monitoring all of the boxes and managing the pick-up of materials just as we did in 2020.
5. The first canvass of mail in ballots will occur on July 21 at 10am. This is open to the public and will be held at the Robert Moton Center Gymnasium. Since this is AFTER Election Day, the results on election night will only encompass early voting and election day totals. Currently, we have a little over 10,400 applications received.

The deadline to request a registered voter list is on June 28, which is also the close of registration. If you are doing voter registration drives, please focus on ensuring people are getting their applications by this date to be sure they have a smooth in person voting process.

If you know of anyone who is NOT working on a campaign, but would like to be a part of the process, we are hiring election judges! Summer elections are particularly difficult to recruit for, so absolutely anyone who is a registered voter could be an election judge and make some extra cash. Please refer them to our [website](#).

Sample ballots are still scheduled to begin going out in late-June, but you can refer to our [website](#) for all of the ballot

styles.

Thank you for your continued patience with my office as we get information out to the public. Please do not hesitate to reach out to me with any questions - no matter how minor you think they are - I will get back to you.

Voter Lookup (District, Polling Place, etc.)

Either of these methods will provide all your current information: district, precinct, and current representatives.

By Name and Date of Birth

To get ALL your current information, including even the status of any mail-in or provisional ballots, go to:

Be sure to **Capitalize** your first and last names - those fields are case-sensitive for some reason.

By Address

If you prefer to search by address, you can do that as well.

Just put in your address. In the results page, click "My Voting Districts".

Update re Mail-In Ballot Applications AND Voter Registration Training

From Katherine Berry, Election Director, Carroll County Board of Elections:

Quick update:

It is my understanding that the State Board of Elections will be putting the remaining mail-in ballot applications (those that registered to vote or had some sort of change to their voter registration record after December 21 or those registered unaffiliated or another third party) in the mail system on June 8. The first set of domestic mail-in ballots will be in the mail system on June 9. This should include everyone prior to May 27 who already requested a mail-in ballot.

I have another voter registration volunteer training scheduled for 1pm on June 2. If you'd like to participate, please let me know!
